New Horizons Training for Building Cisco Multi-Layer Switched Networks (BCMSN) (5-Day) \$2495

This course explores how routing and switching technologies have evolved to meet the growing needs of the campus environment. Through an examination of multilayer switching, we see how Cisco products can provide solutions for campus network design.

(Prerequisites: Familiarity with the fundamentals of internetworking and hands-on experience with basic configuration tasks.)

New Horizons Training For Building Scalable Cisco Internetworks (BSCI) (5-Day) \$2495

This course will help you understand more advanced Cisco networking aspects than an introduction to Cisco routing. You will review complex routing protocols to gain an in depth understanding of internetworking.

New Horizons Training for Interconnecting Cisco Network Devices (ICND) v2.0 (5-Day) \$2295

This course presents the concepts, commands, and practice required to configure Cisco switches and routers in multiprotocol internetworks.



New Horizons Training for Cisco Voice Over Frame Relay, ATM & IP (CVOICE) (5-Day) \$2495

CVOICE is designed to give the student a strong orientation toward Cisco's voice products, after acquiring the basics of voice telephony from the Voice Essentials and the VoIP Essentials classes.

New Horizons Training for Cisco Internetwork Troubleshooting (CIT) (5-Day) \$2495

The course teaches you how to baseline and troubleshoot an environment using Cisco routers and switches for multiprotocol client hosts and servers.

New Horizons Training For Building Cisco Remote Access Networks (BCRAN) (5-Day) \$2495

Advanced level course concentrating on the areas of the network used for remote access connectivity.

New Horizons Training for Cisco Secure PIX Firewalls Fundamentals Adv. (5-Day) \$2495

Provides an intro to network security, focusing on how the PIX Firewall functions within network security. It includes the skills needed to install, configure, and operate the Cisco Secure PIX Firewall.

New Horizons Training for Building Virtual Private Networks (5-Day) \$2495

Advanced level course concentrating on Virtual Private Networks.

New Horizons Training for Cisco Wireless LAN Support Specialist \$2495

As organizations adopt wireless LAN technology in order to extend employee access to critical network resources, they require qualified professionals who can design, install, support, and operate a wireless LAN solution. Cisco Wireless LAN Specialists understand radio technologies associated with WLAN 802.11g standards, WLAN and bridge topologies and applications, can configure WLAN products including access points, bridges, client devices and accessories, can determine best options and configure the appropriate security method for Wireless LAN environments, understand basic antenna theory, understand how to perform a site survey covering WLAN topology and design, and understand vertical market deployment and challenges including equipment utility and cable awareness.

(Prerequisites: Valid CCNA certification)

3042 Novell Network Administration - Netware 6.5 (5-Day) \$2495

In this course, students will learn basic critical skills for managing a NetWare 6.5 network. Students who have entry-level experience in managing computer networks. This course does not require that you have occupational experience with Novell products; however, it does assume you have some prior knowledge of NetWare 6.5.

(Prerequisites: Terminology, hardware, and practices, such as routers, hubs, switches, backbones, and subnets, commonly used in medium to large enterprise networks, 3016 Foundations of Novell Networking: NetWare 6.5)

3043 Advanced Novell Network Administration Netware 6.5 (5-Day) \$2495

In this course, students learn how NetWare 6.5 lowers an enterprises total cost of ownership (TCO), elevates administrator and user productivity, and enhances business productivity. This course is intended for Novell customers who: - Have administration experience with NetWare - Meet the prerequisites for this course - Intend to achieve Novell's CNE 6.5 certification

(Prerequisites: Students should have knowledge or experience with NetWare 6.5, eDirectory, and with managing NetWare storage.)

3060 Getting Started with Linux: Novells Guide to CompTIA's Linux+ (5 Day) \$2495

In this course, students will learn the basic Linux skills needed to perform administrative tasks in SUSE LINUX Enterprise Server 9 (SLES 9). Students preparing for CompTIA's Linux+ exam. Current Novell CNESM certification candidates with experience in other operating systems can also use this course to begin preparing for the Novell CLP Practicum.

(Prerequisites: Students should have some experience working with a Linux desktop or server in a computing environment (such as an enterprise or academic environment).)

3062 Novell ZENworks 7 Desktop Management Administration (5-Day) \$2495

In this course, students learn the skills to install, implement, and administer a GroupWise 7 messaging and collaboration system for internal and external communication. This course is for system administrators, integrators, and engineers, network consultants, and reseller technical support staff.
