1222 Citrix MetaFrame XP Presentation Server Feature Release 3 Adm (4-Day) \$1995

The foundation needed to fully utilize the Citrix MetaFrame XP family; covers installation and administration of MetaFrame XP and ICA clients in varied network environments.

(Prerequisites: Working knowledge of Windows 2000 Server products)

2622 Citrix MetaFrame XP for Win Enterprise Mgmt (2-Day) \$995

Provides Citrix MetaFrameXPe adms. with the skills necessary for comprehensive, enterprise-wide management.

(Prerequisites: 121X or 122X)

JAVA

Intro to Java Programming (5-Day) \$1895

Provides a solid intro to the Java programming language and development environment. In this fast-paced, hands-on course, programmers acquire the skills they need to write stand-alone, client/server, and intranet applications in Java.

(Prerequisites: Background in a structured programming language is recommended.)

Java Program Fundamentals (5-Day) \$1895

Java Programming Fundamentals is designed to teach how to write Java

applications and applets in Java 2.

Active Server Pages 2.0 Level 1 (2-Day) \$795

Students will learn the benefits of using ASP technology to create dynamic, data-driven Web sites. The course introduces the ASP Object Model, several built-in ASP Components, Scripting Objects, and the ActiveX Data Objects (ADO) Model.

(Prerequisites: HTML 4 - L 1 & L 2, Programming - Level 1, SQL Querying - Level 2 Adv. Querying)

ORACLE

Oracle9i - Intro (3-Day) \$1439

Students learn what Oracle is, how companies use it, and the roles and responsibilities of the individuals that create and manage Oracle systems.

(Prerequisites: Programming - Level 1)

Oracle9i Database - Performance Tuning (5-Day) \$2399

Provides students with the concepts needed to properly tune their Oracle9i® database for optimal performance.

(Prerequisites: Oracle9i SQL - Introduction, Oracle9i Database - Fundamentals I & II)

Oracle9i Database - Fundamentals I (5-Day) \$2399

This course introduces students to the responsibilities of an Oracle® database administrator (DBA). You will learn the underlying architecture of the Oracle database server and the essential tasks required to manage database installations.

(Prerequisites: Oracle9i - Introduction, Oracle9i SQL - Introduction)

Oracle9i Database - Fundamentals II (5-Day) \$2399

This course introduces the concepts of Oracle9i® network configuration and database backup and recovery.

(Prerequisites: Oracle9i SQL - Introduction, Oracle9i Database - Fundamentals I)

Oracle 10g Database - New Features for Administrators (3-Day) \$1499

Students identify the most important new features provided in Oracle Database 10g. Students should be experienced with Oracle databases up to and including Oracle9i, and/or already be certified with Oracle9i.

Students should have knowledge of Oracle database utilities, architecture, and terminology, as well as SQL.

(Prerequisites: Experience with Oracle9i or equivalent database administration experience.)

Oracle10g SQL and SQL*Plus (5-Day) \$2399

Introduces the students to the newest features included in the Oracle9i database. Students learn about the latest enhancements to the Oracle9i utilities and tools, such as the Database Configuration Assistant and Oracle Enterprise Manager.

PERL

PERL/CGI Intro (2-Day) \$795

You will learn about the Common Gateway Interface (CGI) protocol for Internet client-server communications, and how to use the Perl programming language to perform common and powerful communications and pro-

cessing tasks on a Web server.

(Prerequisites: HTML 4.01: Web Authoring - Level 1, HTML 4.01: Web Authoring - Level 2 HTML 4.01: Web Authoring - Level 3.)



SCNP Hardening the Infrastructure (5-Day) \$2399

Topics will include: hardening Windows, Linux and Routers, Advanced TCP/IP, IPsec, Contingency Planning, Internet and Web Hardening, and Attack Techniques. This is the first course offered in level One of the Security Certified Program.

(Prerequisites: This course requires working knowledge of TCP/IP Security+ Certification)

SCNP Network Defense and Counter Measures (5-Day) \$2399

This is the second course of the first level of the Security Certified Program. It is focused on understanding the architecture for Network Defense.

UNIX

Unix - Level 1 (2-Day) \$795

Students will learn the basic skills necessary to understand the structure of the UNIX operating system and to use the available utilities and commands to manage their personal file structures in the UNIX C Shell.

Unix Intro - Level 2 (2-Day) \$795

Students will learn more advanced skills to understand the UNIX environment and features. *(Prerequisites: Unix Intro L1)*

Novell

3042 Novell Network Administration - Netware 6.5 (5-Day) \$2495

In this course, students will learn basic critical skills for managing a NetWare 6.5 network. Students who have entry-level experience in managing computer networks. This course does not require that you have occupational experience with Novell products; however, it does assume you have some prior knowledge of NetWare 6.5.

(Prerequisites: Terminology, hardware, and practices, such as routers, hubs, switches, backbones, and subnets, commonly used in medium to large enterprise networks, 3016 Foundations of Novell Networking: NetWare 6.5)

3043 Advanced Novell Network Administration Netware 6.5 (5-Day) \$2495

In this course, students learn how NetWare 6.5 lowers an enterprises total cost of ownership (TCO), elevates administrator and user productivity, and enhances business productivity. This course is intended for Novell customers who: - Have administration experience with NetWare - Meet the prerequisites for this course - Intend to achieve Novell's CNE 6.5 certification

3062 Novell ZENworks 7 Desktop Management Administration (5-Day) \$2495.

This course is for system administrators, integrators, and engineers, network consultants, and reseller technical support staff.
