

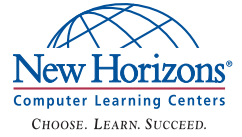

Illustrator CS2 - Level 1 (1-Day) \$249

Overview: Students start by drawing and manipulating simple shapes to create logos. In addition, students will combine text and graphics to create advertisements. / **Prerequisites** - A basic understanding of the computer operating system you are using is recommended.

Illustrator CS2 - Level 2 (1-Day) \$249

Overview: Students will create complex, robust illustrations that go beyond those you could create using Illustrator's basic tools. / **Prerequisites** - Illustrator CS2 - Level 1.

Internet Explorer 6.0 (1-Day) \$199

Overview - Students will learn how to browse and find info. on the Internet.

PhotoShop 7 - Level 1 (2-Day) \$498

Overview - In this course, you will learn to use several tools for selecting parts of images, and will move, duplicate, and resize images. You will learn to use layers, and to apply layer effects and filters to create special effects. / **Prerequisites** - A basic understanding of the computer operating system you are using is recommended. / **Next Steps** - Photoshop 7.0 - Level 2.

PhotoShop 7 - Level 2 (2-Day) \$498

Overview - Students will learn how to use vector paths for a variety of purposes, including masking, clipping paths, and illustration. / **Prerequisites** - Photoshop 7.0 - Level 1.

PhotoShop 7 Artistic Effects (1-Day) \$249

Overview - Students will expand on the skills covered in the Photoshop 7.0 - Level 1 and Level 2 courses by working on a variety of image types. / **Prerequisites** - Photoshop 7.0 - Level 1 & Level 2.

Photoshop CS2 - Level 1 (1-Days) \$249

Overview - Students work with some of the tools and features to edit images using Photoshop CS2. / **Prerequisites** - Basic PC skills: a basic understanding of a computer operating system, launching an application, creating and saving files, and copying files from CDs and other media.

Overview - Students will use Microsoft FrontPage 2003 graphical and convenient tools to add these features to your Web site. / **Prerequisites** - FrontPage 2003 - Level 1.
